Distant Ridges Infinity Scarf

Keep warm all winter with this easy to knit infinity scarf. The use of only knit and purl rows ensure this scarf will knit up quickly. Leave this pattern open ended for a great scarf or graft the ends together for a cozy infinity scarf.

Directions

Cast on 30 stitches.

1: Knit row

2: Knit row

3: Purl row

4: Knit row

Repeat rows 1-4 until desired length is reached. End with row 2. Bind off loosely.

Sew both ends of scarf together to make an infinity scarf.

**Optional: Leave scarf straight for a pretty scarf.

Finished Size

10" wide x 65" long

Materials

Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick and Quick

Approx. 325 yds

Can use any bulky weight yarn

Needles

U.S. 15 (10mm)

Notes/Abbreviations

Need:

Darning Needle (weaving in ends and sewing ends together)

***This pattern can be worked with any number of stitches.

***If using thinner yarn (ie. worsted weight), hold 2 strands of yarn together as you knit and use size US 13 (9mm) needle.
