

# Mockingbird Knits

## High Tide Scarf

The high tide scarf is a great project for intermediate beginners. With emphasis on a Stockinette stitch, Yarn Overs, Decreases you can quickly learn the differences between knit two together (K2TOG) and slip slip knit (SSK). This scarf can be a breeze to finish as most of it is a stockinette pattern (knit 1 row, purl 1 row).

### Finished Size

10.5" x 75.5"

### Materials

Bernat Worsted in  
Dark Heather  
Approximately 400yds  
400g/14oz

### Needles

Size 6 US



## Directions

Scarf is worked in multiples of 17 stitches

Cast on 51 stitches.

1-3: Knit

4: Purl

5: \*K2TOG [3 times], (YO, K1) 5 times, YO, SSK [3 times] repeat from \* to end

6: Purl

7: Knit

8: Purl

9: \*K2TOG [3 times], (YO, K1) 5 times, YO, SSK [3 times] repeat from \* to end

10: Purl

11: Knit

12: Knit

Repeat rows 1-12 2 more times

Knit 2 rows

Purl one row

Continue in stockinette stitch until scarf measures 7" less than desired length. Ending with a purl row

Knit 2 rows

13-14: Knit

15: Purl

16: \*SSK [3 times], (YO, K1) 5 times, YO, K2TOG [3 times] repeat from \* to end

17: Purl

18: Knit

19: Purl

20: \*SSK [3 times], (YO, K1) 5 times, YO, K2TOG [3 times] repeat from \* to end

21: Purl

22-24: Knit

Repeat rows 13-24 2 more times.

Bind off, weave in ends and block (as edges have a tendency to curl).
