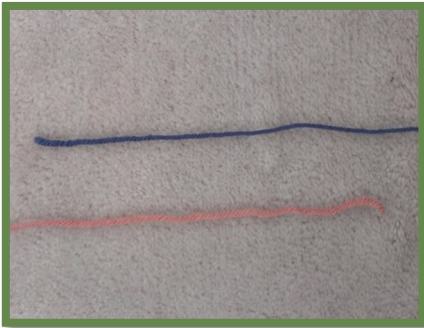


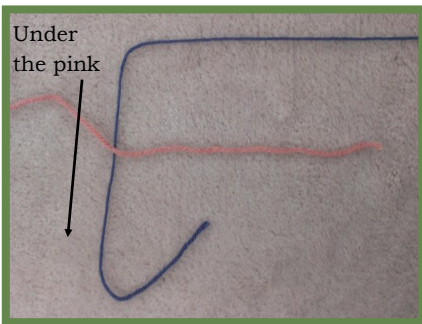
Mockingbird Knits

Tutorial: Joining two yarns

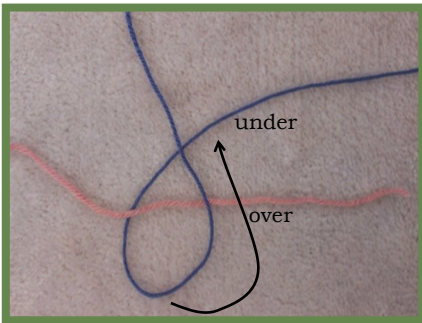
* Note: in this tutorial, the pink yarn is coming from the current project and the purple yarn is coming from the new ball



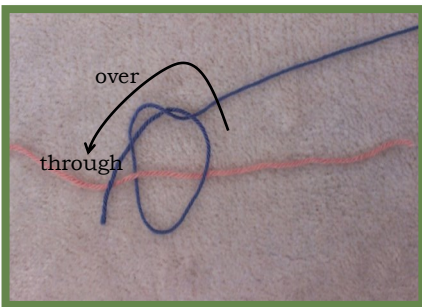
Place both yarns side by side



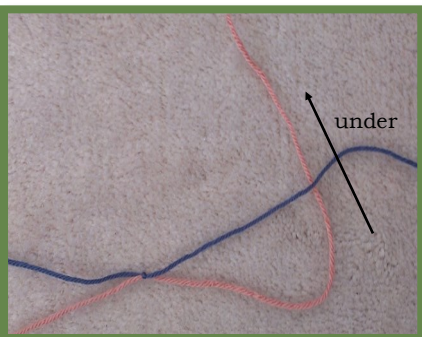
Take the purple yarn and bring it under the pink yarn



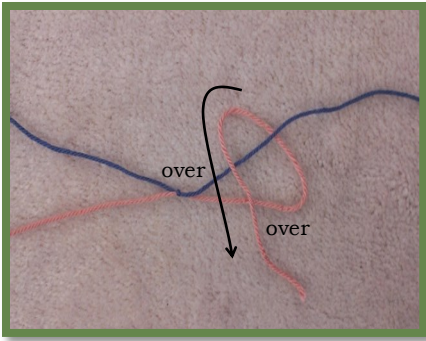
Bring the purple yarn over the pink and then under itself (the purple yarn)



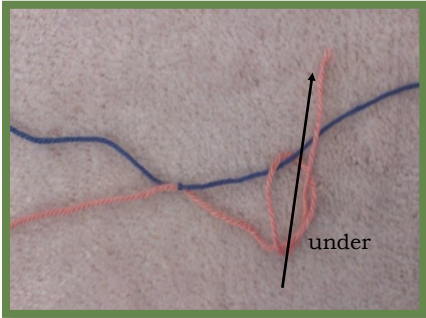
Bring the purple yarn back over and through the hole and pull tight



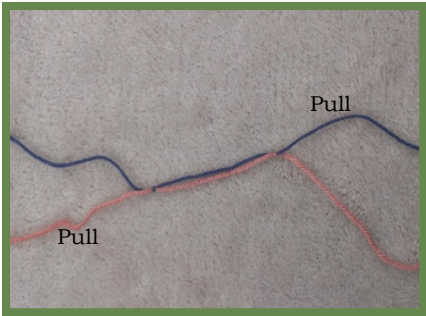
Now bring the pink yarn under the purple yarn



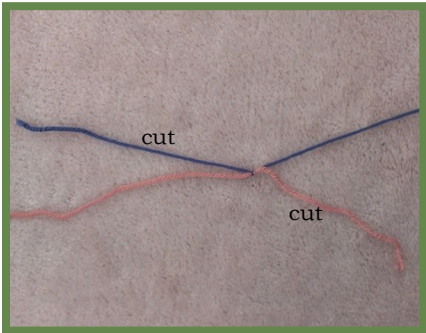
Bring the pink yarn over the purple and then over itself (the pink yarn)



Bring the pink yarn back under and through the hole and pull tight



You will have yarn that looks like this. Now join together the two knots by pulling both yarns apart (do not pull the part of the yarn with the ends)



Once it looks like this, cut the end of the yarn as close to the knots as possible. Don't worry, because of the two knots it will not come undone.



This will be the final result. Much cleaner than a knot where you have to weave in the ends.
